Statement of Claim filed on or about: February 4, 2002. Claimant Just signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: January 31, 2002. Statement of Answer filed by Respondents Stifel Nicolaus on or about: April 18, 2002. Respondent Stifel Nicolaus signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: October 30, 2003. Respondent Shinneman signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: July 15, 2003. Respondent Schenone signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: July 15, 2003.

Claimant Just's Request for the Arbitration Panel's Consent to Submit an Amended Statement of Claim filed on or about: May 09, 2003.

## CASE SUMMARY

Claimant Just asserted the following causes of action: breach of fiduciary duty, churning, omissions of facts, suitability, misrepresentations, negligence, failure to supervise and unauthorized trading.

The causes of action relate to investments in stock.

Unless specifically admitted in their Answer Respondents denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted the following defenses:

- Failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.
- Claimant's damages, if any, were caused by the acts or omissions of third parties over which Respondents had no control.
- Claimant's claims are barred by the doctrines of waiver, estoppel, acquiescence, ratification and laches. Claimant knew or should have known or otherwise had access to information regarding his investments and the status of his accounts and did not object to the transactions in his accounts.
- Respondents did not know or, in the exercise of reasonable care, could not have known of the purported facts upon which Claimant bases his claims.
- Claimant received account statements and confirmations and did not object to the transactions in his accounts.
- The applicable federal and state statues of limitation bar Claimant's claims.
- The negligence and/or fault of Claimant bars Claimant's claims in whole or in part.
- Claimant failed to exercise due diligence in connection with making the investments complained of in the Statement of Claim.
- Claimant failed to mitigate his damages, if any.
- Claimant's claims are barred by reason of second investment decisions made by Claimant with respect to various investments.

## **RELIEF REQUESTED**

Claimant requested:

### **OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED**

During the arbitration hearings, Respondents Kathleen S. Michael, David M. Hogan, and Edward L. Poth were dismissed from the above-captioned matter.

The panel, through NASD, noticed the parties on June 3, 2003 that it granted Claimant's Request to Amend.

### <u>AWARD</u>

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. With respect to Count II Stifel, Nicolaus & Co., Inc., Dalyne L. Shinneman, and Michael E. Schenone are jointly and severally liable for and shall pay to Matthew E. Just, Jr. the sum of \$1,269.00 as compensatory damages.
- 2. With respect to any and all other claims asserted by Claimant Matthew E. Just, Jr. against Stifel, Nicolaus & Co., Inc., Dalyne L. Shinneman, and Michael E. Schenone they are denied and dismissed.
- 3. The Panel recommends the expungement of all reference to the above captioned arbitration from Respondents Kathleen S. Michael, David M. Hogan, and Edward L. Poth's registration records maintained by the NASD Central Registration Depository ("CRD"), with the understanding that pursuant to NASD Notices to Members 99-09 and 99-54, said Respondents must obtain confirmation from a court of competent jurisdiction before the CRD will execute the expungement directive.
- 4. Parties shall each bear their own costs, including attorney's fees.
- 5. Any and all relief not specifically addressed herein, including punitive damages, is denied.

#### **FEES**

Pursuant to the Code, the following fees are assessed:
